1st Nine Weeks Incentive

Students who have met **three of the four goals** for the first nine weeks will receive an incentive in October. The criteria will change every nine weeks.

1. Classroom Discipline -Students should have no more than 2 card flips during the first nine weeks.

2. Bus Discipline- Students cannot have any Bus Discipline Referrals during the first nine weeks.

3. Math iReady -Students must have an average of 80% or above on iReady lessons in Math.

4. ELA iReady -Students must have an average of 80% or above on iReady lessons in ELA.

School Nurse Reminders:

Students SHOULD NOT attend school if they have any of the following:
