VOONBUUNRY

1. <u>matter</u>- anything that takes up space

2. property-a characteristic of something; The way it looks, tastes, smells, sounds, or **feels**

3. <u>physical change</u> a change in the way matter looks

4. solid-matter that is firm and has a certain shape; particles are tight, close, move slightly and stay together

5. Liquid-matter that flows freely and changes shape: particles flow freely and move together

6. <u>gas-</u> matter that has no fixed shape; particles flow freely, spread out, and move quickly

7. melt-change from a solid to a liquid

8. boil-change from a liquid to a gas

9. evaporation-change into a gas without boiling

10. condensation-change from a gas to a liquid

11. <u>freeze</u>-change from a liquid to a solid
