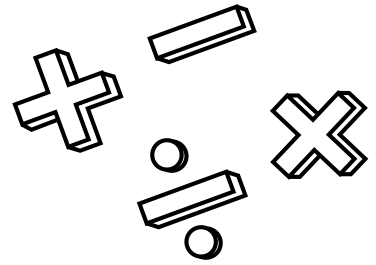

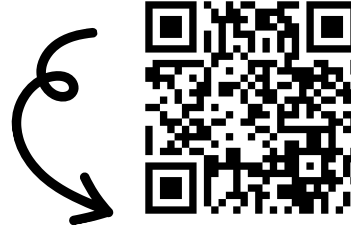

Science Vocabulary

1. environment- all the living and nonliving things in a place
 2. tundra- the coldest environment; few things survive here. (Antarctica is a tundra.)
 3. prairie (grassland)- a type of environment covered in grass
 4. forests- are filled with trees
- *Types of Forests* (3)
5. tropical rainforest- a forest that is warm and rainy all year long; has a LOT of plants (Amazon Rainforest)
 6. temperate forest- a forest that has different weather through the year. (Mississippi forests)
 7. taiga (forest)- this environment is very cold and is a type of forest located Alaska and Canada
 8. desert- there is not much rain fall in this environment, so it is considered to be very dry
 9. ocean- a large body of salt water; 5 oceans
 10. wetland- water covers most of the ground in this environment
