"Antarctic Journal" Vocabulary (test Friday)

1. **anticipation:** act of anticipating; looking forward to; expectation
2. **continent:** one of the seven great land masses on Earth. The continents are North America, South America, Europe, Africa, Asia, Australia, and Antarctica.
3. **Convergence:** act or process of meeting at a point
4. **depart:** to go away; leave
5. **forbidding:** causing fear or dislike; looking dangerous or unpleasant
6. **heaves:** rises: rises and falls alternately
7. **icebergs:** large masses of ice detached from glaciers and floating in the sea. About 90 percent of an iceberg's mass is below the surface of the water.
