- 3. What roles do "lies" and "deception" play in this storyline? Explain the different types of dishonesty shown by various characters in the book.

**Any student who requires extra reading support should have an adult or another fluent reader to assist in the reading of the text to provide support in comprehension. Reading together provides opportunities to hear good reading techniques and allows for conversations about characters, plot, setting, etc. found in the novel while leading you to the answers to the essential questions.
