SUMMER READING

According to the Mississippi College and Career Readiness Standards (CCRS), eighth grade students should read novels that are between the Lexile levels of 805-1100.

SUMMER READING ASSIGNMENT: *Pigman* by Paul Zindel

- Several minor writing assignments and a comprehensive test will be assigned during the first full week of school.
- **All students (regular and honors) will read *Pigman*.**

As you read the novel, keep these essential questions in mind:

1. John and Lorraine find a father-figure in Mr. Pignati and form a group resembling a family. What are some reasons that this family doesn't last?
2. Have Lorraine and John been damaged by their parents' neglectful behavior? If so, how?
3. What roles do 'lies' and 'deception' play in this storyline? Explain the different types of dishonesty shown by various characters in the book.

*Any student who requires extra reading support should have an adult or another fluent reader to assist in the reading of the text to provide support in comprehension. Reading together provides opportunities to hear good reading techniques and allows for conversations about characters, plot, setting, etc. found in the novel while leading you to the answers of the essential questions.
