Pearl Public School District Covid-19 Game Day Guidelines for Spectators

Updated 8/31/2020

In order to follow the guidelines set by Governor Tate Reeve's executive orders and to create a safe environment for participants and spectators alike, the following guidelines have been established for Pearl Public School District extracurricular events.

Attendance/Ticket Information

- Updated 8/31/2020: Attendance will be limited to a maximum of 25% of the venue's seating capacity. 25% capacity of the home side of Ray Rogers Stadium is 875 attendees.
- Season tickets, Pirate Passes, chair back seating, and parking passes will not be sold this year.
- All chair back holders will have their seats saved for the 2021 season.

Spectator Guidelines

- Face coverings are required to be worn, covering the nose and mouth, at all times when it is not possible to maintain a minimum of six feet of social distancing from another person not in the same household. (Note: Wearing a face covering is strongly encouraged even when social distancing is possible).
- Staff will screen the temperature of each spectator before entering the event.
- Gate workers will wear security badges indicating they have had their temperature checked.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided in various locations in the stadium/facility.
- Social distancing should be practiced at all times. Spectators of the same household may sit together, but should be six feet from other spectators.
- There should be no loitering under the bleachers at the stadium; spectators should remain in the bleachers unless going to the restroom or concession stand.
- Spectators will not be allowed on the field/court before, during, or after the game.
- Spectators will be expected to exit the campus in a timely manner.
- There will be no tailgating allowed at this time.
- Football gates will open 45 minutes before kick-off. Volleyball gates will open 20 minutes before game time.
- Players will exit the event area separate from spectators to avoid direct contact.
