Pearl Public School District will again offer drive-up grab and go summer meals 11:00 a.m.–12:30 p.m., Mondays – Fridays, May 31-June 30, 2022, at Pearl Lower Elementary. Children 18 and under will be provided a lunch and breakfast for the next day for free, curbside only. Children must be present to claim their meal.

Adults over the age of 18 can purchase meals (cash only). Lunch is \$3.75 and breakfast is \$2.25 or a total of \$6.00 for both meals. This institution is an equal opportunity provider.

How to login:

- Begin typing your school name, and it will appear in the dropdown box.
- User ID is student MSIS number, without any leading zeroes, followed by @students.pearlk12.com.
 - Example: 1234567@students.pearlk12.com
- Student password is DOB, formatted as M/D/YYYY. Example: 8/1/2005
